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1. Greg talked about a visit from the Park Rangers from the City of Boulder Open Space department. They toured the Shelter and discussed the logistics of open space management related to camping violations and issues related to the homeless.
 2. Todd Bryan officially accepted the invitation to join the Neighborhood/Shelter Action Group (NSAG). Greg will extend an official invitation to Liz Mandel as well.
 3. Greg talked about the current work to update the Statement of Operations (also referred to as the Management Plan) for the 1175 Lee Hill facility. Most of the changes are updates to the tense of the document. Many of the references are relative to the future opening of the facility. For example, passages that begin “The Shelter will provide ...” are being changed to “The Shelter provides ...”.

There was also a description of quarterly meetings that have been changed to an annual meeting.

4. We discussed the recent news of the changes to the Armory space planning. Because of problems with zoning restrictions, there will be less retail space than originally planned and no art studio space. More of the planned space will be for housing.
5. Greg gave a brief updated on the Resource Center at the Shelter saying that they are seeing approximately 20 people per day of operation with the vast majority being overnight clients. There are very few walk-up clients. The low numbers, plus the availability of RTD bus tokens has resulted in very minimal impact on the North Boulder neighborhood.
6. Because of winter weather, no progress has been made on the trash issues on the stretch of Broadway north of the Shelter.
7. Greg has met with Amanda Nagl, the City of Boulder Neighborhood Liaison, about sub community planning but there wasn't much to discuss at this time.
8. The next meeting of the NSAG will be on Tuesday March 8.
