1. This was the first meeting since the summer break after the June meeting. There were only three of us in attendance.
 2. Greg talked the opening day of emergency sheltering which would begin on October 1. This has been the traditional start of Emergency Sheltering although the last couple of years have seen services commence on October 15 for budgetary reasons.
 3. Friday, September 11, will be the annual United Way Day of Caring. Volunteers from the Boulder Valley community and North Boulder neighbors will join Boulder Shelter staff in various Shelter projects and neighborhood clean up.
 4. Greg talked about the status of the collaboration between the Boulder Shelter, the Bridge House, and BOHO.

Following some questions voiced during the previous week, Gregg discussed the plans to support the Bridge House and their Resource Center at the Boulder Shelter. As discussed in the June NSAG meeting, this would provide services to Boulder Shelter clients following morning services three days a week. The Resource Center would be available to Shelter clients to augment the other two days of service at the First Presbyterian Church. This will add services such as job connections, addiction groups, Veteran's services and parole services to the Shelter. No significant impact on the neighborhood is expected.

5. For those who may have noticed some work at the back of the Shelter, the fence surrounding the Boulder Shelter courtyard has been replaced.
